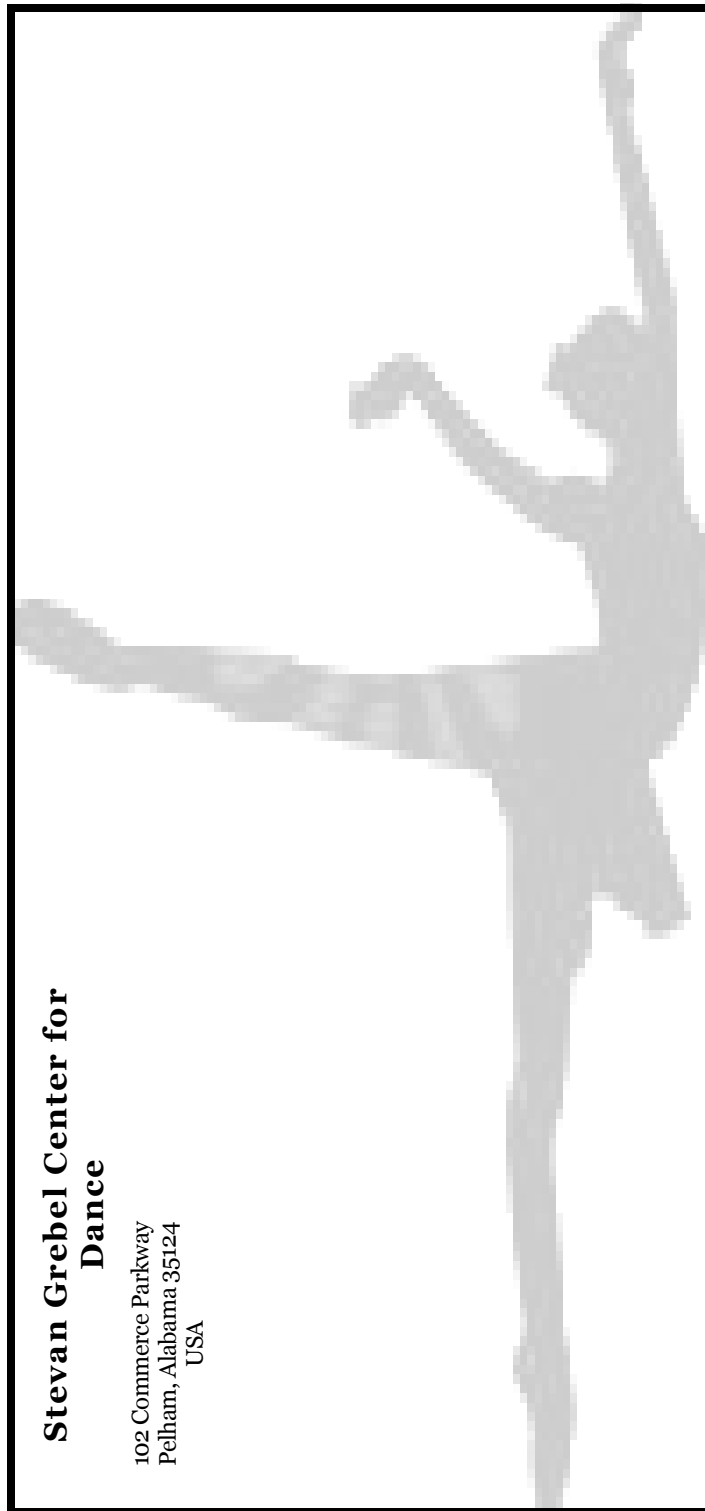


Grebel Ballet

Stevan and Deborah Grebel have been teaching dance in the Birmingham area consistently for 40 and 30 years. The Stevan Grebel Center For Dance in Pelham is conveniently located .5 miles from I-65 at Hwys. 31 & 119 behind the Purple Onion Restaurant. At Grebel Ballet, Stevan and Deborah Grebel offer pre-professional training, private coaching, and professional training for the intense students who desire specific and personally integrated work. Furthermore, beginning and regular pre-ballet classes are offered to children 3-5, adult ballet classes and recreational classes. Ballet and ballet-related classes are taught, primarily, and they are complemented with jazz, modern, stretch and character dance..It is the Grebel's belief that one can fully "experience and enjoy the freedom of dance through pure technique."Ballet technique is the basis for all forms of dance, and the students who attend the academy are looking for a strong foundation. Classes are small, as individual attention to each student is imperative to the growth and development of great technique. The Grebel's mentor each student, who desires to study.

Stevan Grebel was trained by the foremost teacher of classical ballet in the world, Alexander Pushkin, at the Kiroallet in Russia, in the Vaganova method. No other syllabus develops the elegant long lines, high extensions, musicality, strength and crystal-clear style that is so representative of Vaganova technique. Moreover, Grebel has worked with great teachers, dancers and choreographers such as George Balanchine, Frederic Franklin, Leonide Massine, George Skibine, Edward Caton, Roland Petite, Rudolf Nureyev, Eric Bruhn, Rosella Hightower, Ludmilla Tcherina, Sonia Arova, Ivan Nagy, Dmitri Parlic, John Taras, to name a few. He is the artistic director of the Alabama Youth Ballet Company. The Grebels' extensive work in ballet has made them respected leaders in classical ballet training in Alabama and the world.

Debbie Grebel began ballet at the age of 6 with Frances Armstrong, and later studied at the Alabama Civic Ballet . She was a member of the Alabama Ballet, University Ballet and studied and danced in Cannes, France with Rosella Hightower, and a renowned faculty . She has an M.A.Ed in Dance Kinesiology. Debbie is the chairman and founding director of the Alabama Youth Ballet Company.

Information and Policies

TUITION

One hour of class per week is \$65.00 monthly. After 5 hours of classes a week, the rate is reduced. Any amount over 8 hours per week is \$400.00 monthly. There is a 10% discount for each additional child. There is a 10% Discount for Tech III – V paying full yearly tuition. Tuition may be paid by check, cash; or online by MC, Visa and Discover. Private lessons are \$90/hour. All fees are non-refundable and may not be transferred to pay for classes. You will be responsible for all months through May.

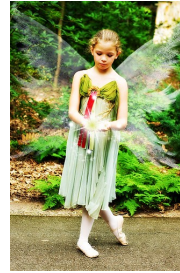

ALABAMA YOUTH BALLET auditions are held twice a year, in May and August. Company members pay discounted tuition, however, the contract is for 12 months, from August to August. Junior Company members are 8 - 12 and Senior Company members are ages 12 –19. AYBC members take 3-4 ballet classes per week, along with jazz and/or modern. Placement in Junior and Senior Company depends on student's age, first, then ability.

SPRING BREAK & HOLIDAYS

Grebel Dance is closed on all major holidays. Also, we will be closed anytime the Shelby County Schools are closed. From time to time, workshop classes will be offered during a holiday break period or on weekends. These classes will be announced ahead of time, and are for the intermediate to advanced students from ages 10 and up. All workshop fees are non-refundable and non-transferrable.

The Spring Concert (recital) will be in May at Hoover High School Theatre. The students of Grebel Dance will perform with the AYBC. All tuition and fees must be paid in full in order for the student to participate. Rehearsals begin after Spring Break and will be in class after barre-work, and on weekends. There will be full cast rehearsals the week before the concert, and dress rehearsal tba. The recital requires teamwork, so please do not commit to any other major activities at this time. There will be a \$15 fee for each missed rehearsal. Three rehearsals missed and the student may be taken out of the production.

Performance fee: \$65 per student, non-refundable Performance Fee is due by December 1st. It is to cover rental of theatre, programs, sets, lights, clean-up, and stage hands. Included in this fee is one ticket for each student.

Costume fee: Baby Ballet & Creative Movement \$85, Pre-Ballet, Ballet I \$95, Ballet II, III: \$100.00, Ballet III-VI \$125, Jazz/Lyrical \$85, each costume.

THE NUTCRACKER will be held in December (tba) at the Pelham High School Auditorium. This is an annual family and community endeavor, which does involve some commitment. All rehearsals are mandatory. Volunteers, and talents donated, are extremely appreciated! Fee: \$100/dancer.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Tuition is due by the 25th of the previous month and late after the 5th. There is a \$10.00 late fee on any tuition paid after the 5th. There is a \$25 return check charge. By-the-class must be paid prior to entrance into class. Monthly tuition is based on the number of classes averaged out for the year (36 weeks), not for the number of classes in a month. **Grebel Dance** requires 30 days notice, in writing, for withdrawal from classes or for a decrease in number of classes taken. You will be billed for all months prior to w/d. Missed classes may be made up in the month they were missed. There will be no refunds on missed classes.
